#### 1982

Club founded.

Details are sketchy of this era, but from the information available:

Founder members included Steve Flynn, a Quaker Social Worker now in Eire and Roy Millington, now a touring cyclist.

Glossopdale <u>does not</u> enter a team in Chew Valley Skyline, Edale Skyline, Kinder Downfall, Tour of Tameside or Glossop "Women's Refuge" 5. The Glossop Fell Race (18 mile / 400 ft) on 4 July saw Andy Addis in second, the first local, help East Cheshire H to win the team. Club train out of Hadfield School.

The Glossop "Women's Refuge" 5, organised by Mr G Claff of Salford H and endorsed by Seb Coe, was won by Gerry Helme in 23:39. The first local was John Eaveson (Salford H) 22nd in a field of 196.

Glossop FR 4 July (18 miles / 4000ft) A Addis, in second, is first local. Mark Elsegood (5) and Shaun Priestley (8) form the ECH team - join the Harriers in the near future. F Lowe (47) and N Kirk (49) are unattached. Windermere marathon - Nev M.cGraw (u/a) 627th 3:28:29, Carl Buckley (u/a) 922nd in 3:45:46.

## 1983

In May they organise the first MIDCO Half Marathon which Jeff Norman wins in 1:05:26 from John Eaveson (Salford) 1:07:10, also first local. The Glossop contingent were: 17 Mike Prady 1:14:49; 19 Dave Ibbetson 1:14:57; 50 D Little 1:21:02; 62 Nev McGraw 1:22:07; 68 Pete Griffies 1:22:34; 77 Fran Lowe 1:24:05; 100+ Howard Rees 1:29:52; 100++ Roy Millington 1:34:19. Also Vinny Wathey 1:35:37. and Neil Boardman 1:32:45. 333 ran. The 1986 MIDCO ½ M is rated the 4th best race in UK behind Derby & London Marathons for organisation etc.

New Mills (6.3 mile) Road Race. Won by John Eaveson (Salford H) 32.37; Ron Hill (9th & 1st V40) 33.49 M.Prady 50th 36.39, Ibbetson 51st 36.41; Nev McGraw 148th 40.36, Fran Lowe 155th 40.52; Steve Cannon 212th 43.42; Howard Rees 217th 43.55.

Tour of Tameside saw five enter with 63 D Ibbetson; 127 N McGraw; 146 P Griffiths; 160 G R Davey; 205 P A Mee Female; 229 D S Fearnley. Last was Mark Parish. The team was 17th (of 29) – results after 3 races. Club's first winner: Pat Mee, first woman in North Wales Marathon 3:09. Turnslack FR – M Prady (6); Daves Ibbetson (21) and Crooks (53); R Millington (193); 205 ran. Glossopdale 8th team.

Borrowdale M Prady 100th in 3:55 (but without a club).

Three Towers P Griffies 99th Fran Lowe 191 from 200.

Autumn Leaves ½ mar M Prady second, 50 yards off the winner.

North Wales Marathon (16 Oct) Pat Mee - first woman in 3:09, a PB.

<u>Tanky's Trog</u> 116 Nev Kirk; 124 Malcolm Maddock; 169 Fran Lowe 240 ran.

# 1984

M Prady won the three day at Saddleworth 156:08 with D Ibbetson 6th. In Hyde 7 on Bank Hol Mon team 9th – 68 D Vickers u/20; 74 Neil Boardman; & 93rd V McKay. B Buckley was 35th & 4th vet in the 5th

Chew Valley Skyline 306 ran. Mike stretchered off. Dave Ibbetson lost: due to Pete G's navigation.

Bill Buckley 5th vet in Three Peaks and on the same day John Brightmore runs a 1:20 in James Herriot ½ M.

Bill Buckley runs SPELGA Skyline fell race in N Ireland.

Entries to P Griffies (£1.50) 9th lady E Dyer 4:05:24. Also a junior race. Up The Nab, a new race on 22 Aug, saw M Prady 1st in 25:00; A Trigg 3rd 25:11; Ibbetson 8th 26:29; 12 D Vickers 27:03; Roy Millington was 5th vet & L Rose the 6th lady 36:32. Junior race 1st John Taylor 27:35 saw T Byrne 3rd 31:39 and C Rees 4th 34:34 with S Jones 6th 34:47.

On 1 Jan Club has 57 members: 6 female, 7 new members and 44 others. Fran Lowe is Sec; Roger May Treasurer; A Jones Captain and Liz Sparkes Womens' Rep. The 1985 club championship will be the best 7 from 12 races – comprising 9 nominated incl. Welsh 1,000m and Marsden to Edale; any (road) marathon and two cross-country races. In Mar at Spen 20 (rd) team 2nd with D Ibbetson 3rd 1:51; 9th A Trigg 1:53; Neil Boardman 2:05; V McKay 2:06. Bill Buckley is 1st vet in Manx Mountain Marathon. Dave I's runs 2:34 marathon at Stockport. Good turnouts in Hyde 7 and Saddleworth 3 day. Tour of Tameside sees club out in force – 92 Neil B; 123 John Collins; 173 John B; 187 John H; 210 Nev; 299 Phil; 337 Kevin; 368 Colin; Vets – 283 Claude Foley; 320 Mike McKenna; 341 Roy. Cross Keys relay A team – Dave I; Mike P; Alan, Des Gibbons 7th team. B team Tim Ryan; Ian Fletcher; Shaun Priestley; Cameron Campbell John Hyde – alias Dr Jekyll – is in his element editing the newsletter. # 1986

LATE NEWS – John Hyde reports Peter Griffies filed a report dated 14 Jan 1986 that on 20 Aug 1985 he became Bob Graham member 370. An exclusive quote: "By now (after 20 hours.) I was feeling knackered." (Neil Shuttleworth does Bob G in Sept 1986.) At 1986 AGM Nev McGraw acting Chairman with Bill B Acting Sec. Elected Chair J Hyde; Sec Kevin Toms; Tres T Ryan; Capt Nev; Road sec V McKay; CC Sec Bill B. 12 run in Heaton Park CC Relays: A team was Ray Ball; Tim Ryan; Trevor Hill and John Collins. In National CC 1986 team is 167th Tim R 854th; Ray B 1154; 1232 Shaun P; 1348 John C; 1367; W Buckley 1436 John H; 1552 John B; 1621 Nev M; 1680 Kev T. Ten or more run in Coniston Fell; Kinder Downfall; Wardle Skyline.

John Collins runs 2:48 in Barmouth Marathon.

Dave I 5th in well-attended Werneth Low in arctic conditions. Andy Trigg wins Glossop 5; Bill B runs in Jura; excellent turnout in Tour, and own Glossop Fell Race.

Sharon and Adrian marry prompting headline: RUNNING TO HAPPINESS. Many in Karrimor: Liz Sparkes & Shaun 1st Mixed C class.

LATE NEWS: Carl B was 40 in Dec 86 and had a superb Birthday Run. Tim Ryan is destined to be Club Champ followed by Ray Ball, with third joint vets champs J Hyde and N Shuttleworth. In 10th is the next vet Ray Brown Club organise Midco (1 A Trigg 1:11; 3 M Prady; 11th Cameron C; Pat Mee (Altrincham) 1st female.) Club has teams in races like Kinder Trog; Coniston Fell (39th A Trigg) Chew Valley 19 out Ibbetson 1st in 15th 1:54. Edale 8 run; 28th M Prady 3:08; 2 retirees Phil Marland; K Toms. Two return to Spen 20: 31st J Collins 2:05 & 42nd V McKay 2:07.

Kinder Downfall 26 out for club: 2nd M Prady 66:09.
Teams seen in Marple 7; Otter ½ M, Altrincham 10; Holmfirth 15.
Club organise three races (+ Midco ½). M Prady wins Glossop 5 (24:57); A Trigg wins Up The Nab (25:37) and Shelf Moor (43:38).
"John Hyde, a super-fit 40-year-old father of three" said *Man Even News*, joins Ray Ball for a 6-day jaunt: the Pennine Way N to S supported by *inert alia* Kevin and Mike Toms. Prepared with 5:09 in Haworth Hobble. Hon Sec Kevin T reported 50 members with 2 women and 2 2nd claim, one being Des Gibbons about whom he had corresponded re: his status. A Trigg (11th in Langdale) 1st in Marsden to Edale 2:38. Year ends with Barnsley Mar – points-chasing Shuttleworth lost out to canny Vaughan McKay 2:58 to 2:59. Sandy Simpson, close behind, set to improve a lot.

## 1988

For 87 /88 CC season club entered in Manchester & SE Lancs Leagues. At 88 AGM Club Tres says net loss on 1987 year is £292.50. 29 runs in CC & discuss buying a club tent. to erect at races. MIDCO gets help from Cystic Fibrosis; Tim R moves to N Yorkshire and reports on 13<sup>th</sup> place in Bentham Gala. Trevor Andrews reviews his 3:50:32 (London.) John Brightmore has a leg op; Nev McGraw & T Hill do Derwent Watershed in daylight – Snake to Snake 7:05 am to 6:20 pm. Bill B & Rob Poole - Old County Tops, 37 mile/10,000ft from Langdale. A Trigg misses record in Glossop Fell by 5 secs. Carl B; N S and Nev run at back amazed at stamina of "super-gran" Angela Soper. Carl reports on DISASTER ON THE PROM, a report of his 3:13:49 at Blackpool with Daves I; Arnold et al. Glossop 5 on 27 Dec; Alan Kirk Hayfield Champ; Otter 40 1st team is Ray Ball; Tim Ryan; Bill B & Rob Poole.

FOOD POISONING STRIKES ran the front page of the *Chronicle* as a result of Harriers 'Dinner Do' at Golf Club.

Ray Brown, a 52 year-old chemical salesman, is THE Club Champion.

Mike Whyatt second at Chew Valley only six seconds behind Pudsey's Gary Devine but club takes team prize; Pennine organise first Herod Farm race (Ibbetson 1st, Adi 2nd). A Trigg wins Saddleworth 3 day again in (amazingly) the same overall time as Dave Crookes when he won it in 1985. This places them 2nd on the all time list behind the great Jack Maitland who won in 1986 chased hard by Mike Neary; A Trigg also wins the Glossop Half in 1:11:52. Harriers 3 rd team in the British Fell Champs (thanks to Mike P, Mike W and A Trigg) Cameron wins inaugural Charlesworth Fell Race from Adi Jones. Carl 4th and 1st vet. Pat Mee 1st lady and John Collins 1st vet at John Brightmore's race held on a June evening.

Prady 2nd at Marple 7 in a classy field. British Fell Champ Colin Donnelly under 40 minutes at Shelf Moor; no one really close ever since! Mike P and Mike W. set pbs chasing in 2nd and 3rd. John Nudds 15th in 56.23 at Sale 10. Excellent turnout at the Otter 40; Ray Ball (2nd) Brian Howbrook (9th) Rob Poole and Trevor Hill (12th), Bill B and Phil Wheatcroft (16th), John Miller (22nd).

Mike Prady (4th in British Fell Champs 88) runs in World Fell in Die, France: 16th; 2nd Eng;. In open race: Mike Whyatt 5th; A Trigg 8th. John Kewley and partner runner-up and Poole / Buckley 1st vets in Mournes Mountain Marathon that autumn.

Ray Ball won his first ever race – Combs Fell race 21:08. Phil Wheatcroft - 11th in race - completes the Bob Graham round (prepared with a double Mardsen to Edale in Jan!!)

# 1990

In National CC team is 143rd with 6,288 points. ## 1991

18 run at Woodbank Park, 11 brave the blizzards at Silver Springs. Glossopdale at the Nationals in Luton. 16 runners out at the Werneth Low Half; A Trigg 3rd, Alan Kirk 5th, John N 8th; Club photo taken outside Leisure Centre by NS for posterity (can you name them all?). A Trigg, narrowly beaten by Donnelly at the Edale Skyline, is runner-up in Three Peaks race, wins Buttermere Fell Race. Bill R, Bill C and Andy W join club. A Trigg wins at the Hayfield May Queen; Ennerdale revisited Rob (30th 2nd V40), Bill (43rd 3rd V45), Nev (71st); Rob and Bill also in good form at the Old County Tops (4th and 1st V90 pair) and win the Mournes MM to round off a year of highs; Bill Clayton wins the Dog Rock Handicap race after a stewards' enquiry; Nev 3rd V45 at the Tour; Second claim Bill Fox wins the Otter 40, Ray and Rob finish well to claim team prize; Carl helps Broadbottom CC to put on a low key village run around the Mudd and Hurst Clough. Irene, Hilary, Louise, Liz and Jacqui register good team performance at Horwich CC; Adi Club Champion from Simon E, Vaughan 1st Vet, Hilary Ladies Champ

#### 1992

22 Harriers contest Mickleden Straddle, a club champs race, (Adi 4th) Mark S and Ray Ball lead home the team in the Nationals at Newark. Mark wins New Chew O the following day! Pat Mee 1st Lady Vet SE Lancs, Ladies team 4th, A Trigg 2nd in M/C League Ladies team takes 2nd prize at the Parbold Hill Race. Club enter Ian Roberts Relay. Bill, Rob, Ray and Martin Cuddy 8th in the Watersheds in 10:56. Andy Trigg

wins Goat Fell & Bens of Jura. Ray 2nd, Rob 3rd at the Calderdale Hike. Martin Cuddy 2nd at Saddleworth. A Trigg wins Holme Moss, conditions 'the hottest in any race to date'. 16 Harriers complete the Tour. John Taylor wins from A Trigg & Adi at Shelf Moor (41:48). Bill and Rob 1st Vets at the Mournes. Seddon/Trigg 2nd in blizzard-swept Keswick Karrimor, Rob & Bill a gallant 24th. Paul Deaville pips Adi at the Famous Grouse, last fell race counter in Club Champs. Icy Marsden-Edale, the 'toughest ever,' won in record slow 3:41 by Mark Seddon from A Trigg. 10 other Harriers finish incl Edwina Hill & Kate Lucas. Hurrells' Hash run enjoyed in Sept & Martin M 1st back at Dog Rock Handicap.

A team finishes Calderdale Way Relay. 23 harriers at Nev's fell Race won by A Trigg from Simon Clayton. In Dec 92 Vets team 2nd in Derbyshire CC 2nd John Nudds; 6th Frank Fielding; 17th Ray Ball; 26th John Collins. Also Nev McGraw 28th; Adi retains club championship narrowly from John Nudds, the Vet 40 champ. Hilary Ladies Champ.

## 1993

Sue Sharkie-Hurrell, in Club chair & hubby Jon as club captain; Rob Poole editing and assembling a regular quality newsletter; Northern CC at Blackburn is a breakthrough for club – Sally Newman's 87th along with Hilary Bell and Fiona Murphy is first time we've had a ladies team in the area championship. Simon E breaks three hours at Edale. Lager Louts 8th Team at the Watersheds; recipes begin appearing in the newsletter as club becomes more PC!

Harriers sweep the board at Saddleworth with Ibbetson 1st, Mike P 2nd, Dale 3rd, Adi 5th, Sally 28th and 1st Woman; Harriers also win team prize at Jura; Jon and Sue organise a Tuesday night Hash and 2 informal O events on Shelf Moor; 4 teams out at the Old County Tops with Sally and Pat Mee first womens' team; several contest the SLMM on a wet weekend in the Howgills; teams in Cross Keys Relays; Bill Buckley bites the bullet and finishes the Tour with 16 others; Mark Seddon wins KIMM elite for 1st (of countless) time; London-based Lou Myers finishes Pikes Peak Marathon in Colorado, USA;

Of the 215 in Marple 7 we have 18 who run, and Dale Gartley is 14th.

D Ibbetson wins Derbyshire vets CC in foul weather at Heanor and John N, Ray and Pete pack well for 2nd Team; A Trigg wins Tanky's Trog in 2:45 with Adi 2nd, Mark S. 3rd; 17 finish Nev's Fell race with many in fancy dress; Dale and Sally Club Champs.

Good turnouts in the CCs; Rob still putting out regular quality newsletters with Simon Entwisle (Captain) chronicling good team representation at the Englsh and British Champs; Feb Annual Club Presentation dinner at the George; Womens' team at Northern CC at Blackburn comprised of Hilary Bell; Donna Hunter; Sally Newman; & Edwina Hill. Good turnout at Black Combe and Moel Fammau in FRA Champs;

Lou Myers, a London-based OAP runs Haworth Hobble with Neil S. S Winspear (Holmfirth) wins the clubs ½ M Shelf Moor now 5.9 miles to comply with definition of short race. John Kewley is 3rd in Mourne A class Mount Marathon.

Steve Winspear (Holmfirth) wins the clubs ½ M in 1:12:38; Frank wins 35 mile Calderdale Hike (6:52) with good support from Rob, Bill and Ray; only 1 minute separates Nev & Alan F from Pat & Sal after 31 mile Haworth Hobble; programmes of regular pack runs 186 finish 'Up and Running' Glossop Half with Ken Ward published: (14th) and Lee Tetler (26th); First team again at Goatfell where Andy T still holds record; Pete G finishes 61 mile Fellsman Hike; Jon Hurrell completes Bob Graham with good support; club well represented in the Saunders based on Langdale; Shelf Moor acquires portable loos as it is a Fell Championship race; Dale wins at Passing Clouds and just shading club champs from Adi mid-season; D Ibbetson second vet in the English Champs, Andy Trigg 6th in both the English and British Champs; Mark S and John K win Nev's 3 Trigs by 14 mins from Bill C. and Martin M. as a warm up for the KIMM which Mark Seddon clinches again 2 weeks later (see also 1995!) New Glossop Fell race held in October and won by Adi Jones in 3.22 from Rob Taylor, Andy W 11th and Lee T 17th (rest of us marshalling! – or vetting kit for MEP–to-be Chris Davies); Dale and Adi share Club Champs, Frank 1st Vet

#### 1995

Club 'Do' held at the new Community House; A Trigg 2nd at Parbold; Simon edits newsletter; Lager Louts (Ball, Fielding & Poole) co-opt Barry Hobbs on to their team and win bronze at the Watersheds, where he wore SWAFT – Secret Weapon Against Frozen Toes – then becomes 'King Herod' and organises the April event where there is a club 1, 2, 3. Lesley 2nd woman; Martin Cuddy 5th at Shining Tor; Mark Kinch takes 2 mins off the Downfall record as the Champs road-show hits Hayfield,

A Trigg 2nd Adi and Dale also in tough top 20; club represented on Arran and Jura. Shaun and Liz stage 'Women Only' Fell Race from the Drovers won by ECH Ros Dunnington with Sally 2nd; Edwina Hill organises Up the Nab won by A Trigg in 24:48 to = record. Nev sets mark for the newly-opened 40 mile Tameside Trail; Nev & Pete 11th, Ray and Frank 12th in SLMM Scafell Class at Coniston; John Pollard 1st Harrier back at the *Brother* Tour of Tameside; 4 teams out at the Cross Keys relays with A team shaded by a strong Salford quartet; 16 Harriers at Tintwistle Resrs (then 4.67 miles) Paul Roden won (24:07); No Shelf Moor due to closure of access land as a result of dry weather. Kewley and Seddon win KIMM Elite in Brecon Beacons. Andy Wilkins is Club Champion.

#### 1996

Alan Kirk 2nd at Werneth Low and 3rd at Cloud Nine; A Trigg 3rd at Pendle; Harriers in team prize at Shining Tor; Frank first Harrier back at Edale Skyline; Edwina Hill does Crowden to Ilam YHA 50 miler. A Trigg & Dale 1st and 2nd at Herod Farm. 18 Harriers at Tame Valley;

Nev reaches 50 & completes 15 Dark Peak Trigs with Glossopdale help; Graham Hill (Stockport) wins Up the Nab in 26:02.

Bill C. and John P win 3 Trigs narrowly from Carl and Rob;

Paul Deaville, Alan Kirk, Martin Cuddy, Mark S, A Trigg and Adi finish in an excellent 9th place at the FRA Relays at Sedbergh;

Club now putting on 8 races (Gallop, Lambs Leg, Herod, Ten, Womens', Up the Nab, Shelf, New Glossop Fell); Adi Jones is Club Champion.

7 runners out at the Northern CC Champs in Durham;

At Lambs Leg A Trigg 1st, Simon E 8th. 10 runners out at Black Combe and English Fell counter, Adi 4th vet, Harriers 5th team; London Calling: Frank Fielding 2:54:56, life-time best; Nev McG (3:24). 'Crisis' AGMs held in April and May to discuss Simon's questionnaire and the future of the club; Club well represented at Stuc a Chroin Fell Counter; In July Tour of Tameside Vets win team. Adi Jones 24th (5:13);
